Kansas Legislative Hearing Raises Questions About State's Facility Conservation Improvement Program

The Kansas Legislative Sub Committee on the Facility Conservation Improvement Program (FCIP) held a hearing on January 28th to discuss performance contracting in the state and the status and future of the FCIP. Committee members heard educational presentations on the history of performance contracting and how it works.

The committee asked the Kansas Corporation Commission for more detailed information on its FCIP projects, their scope, projected energy and dollar savings, status of projects, and M&V performance results. Six school districts, two school organizations and one
